

What is the Study Edge Scholarship?

- Study Edge wants to give back to the departments whose students we serve. Each semester, Study Edge awards a scholarship to outstanding students in one of those departments. The Spring 2018 Study Edge Scholarship will be awarded to two physics students at the University of Florida.

Who is eligible to apply?

- At the time of award disbursement, the recipients must...
 - be full-time enrolled undergraduate students at the University of Florida.
 - be pursuing a degree in physics *or* pursuing a degree in a related major while minoring in physics.
 - be in good academic standing.
 - have completed at least two 3000- or 4000-level UF courses with the PHY or PHZ course code prefix with a grade of "B" or better.

What are the details of the award?

- Applications will be accepted starting on October 14, 2017, and will close on February 1, 2018.
- Applications will be evaluated by a panel of judges, including Study Experts from Study Edge.
- Two awards will be disbursed directly to the winners in March of 2018: A first place prize of \$1000 and a second place prize of \$500.

How do I apply?

- Email your responses to the following questions to scholarship@studyedge.com, and attach a PDF copy of your unofficial UF transcript. If you apply before Fall 2017 grades are included on your transcript, you must send a follow-up email later, including a transcript with those grades.
 - *Short answer:* What is your full name? What are your majors and minors?
 - *Essay (750 word limit):* Why did you choose to study physics, and what are your career goals?
- Ask a member of the UF physics faculty to email a letter of recommendation to scholarship@studyedge.com on your behalf.
