

What is the Real Life 101 Internship?

- The Real Life 101 Internship is available to 10 UF students, from any class or major. You'll get real-world work experience in a professional environment to prepare for life after college, learning about topics like taxes and buying versus leasing a car. This internship also provides college students with exciting and engaging opportunities to develop new skills and see first-hand how a company is run - from balancing a budget to leasing your first building.

What does the program entail?

- You'll spend 1 hour per week in a discussion about a business-related topic. These meetings will take place each Tuesday during 5th and 6th periods at the Study Edge building. Attendance is mandatory, so please plan accordingly in your course schedule.
- Additionally, you'll spend 2-3 hours a week working on various tasks including: company operations, meeting with other business leaders in town, or volunteering in the community.
- Each member of the internship program will be assigned a project in a field such as marketing, operations, technology, or within Math Nation, a sister product we created.

What are the benefits of the program?

- You can receive up to two (2) college credits through the University of Florida Honors Program (even if you aren't in the Honors Program) or count this towards your internship credit in the College of Business.
- After completing the program, you will receive consideration when Study Edge is hiring for part-time and full-time positions.
- A free Study Edge Diamond membership during your internship semester.
